AUGUST 9, 2009

Vintage 242 officially launched into the Cedarcrest area. Meeting in a 1400 square foot space and renting a dance studio for our children at Bentwater Village, 70 adults worshipped together for the launch of Vintage 242. Within two years, we grew to over 200 adults and were running three services and recognized it was time to move.

To accommodate our numerical growth, Vintage 242 moved into our current space in Acworth Village




-APRIL 28, 2017
